Day 0) Sept 23 – Enjoy your flight to Italy

Day 1) Sept, 24 – Arrival in Venice

Day 3) Sept, 26 – Venice → Florence

Day 4) Sept, 27 - Florence

In the morning, embark on a guided walking tour of Florence, strolling through its elegant streets, lively squares, and centuries-old neighborhoods as your guide brings the city's rich artistic heritage to life. The tour continues with a visit to the Accademia Gallery, where you will have the chance to admire Michelangelo's magnificent David along with other notable masterpieces. Return to your hotel for a relaxing and well-deserved dinner in hotel (B, D)

Day 5) Sept, 28 – Chianti Region

Enjoy a full-day excursion through the picturesque Chianti region, renowned for its rolling hills, vineyards, and medieval charm. Your day includes guided visits to Siena and San Gimignano, where you can wander through historic squares, admire centuries-old architecture, and soak in the atmosphere of Tuscany's most enchanting towns. The experience is completed with a wine tasting at a local winery, where you will sample some of the region's celebrated wines accompanied by traditional flavors. Return to your hotel for a relaxing and well-deserved dinner in hotel (B, WT, D)

Day 6) Sept, 29 – Florence → Assisi

After breakfast depart for Assisi. Enjoy a guided walking tour of this historic town, wandering through its medieval streets and charming squares. Visit the magnificent Basilica of Saint Francis, a UNESCO World Heritage site, with its remarkable frescoes by Giotto and other renowned artists. Stroll through the Piazza del Comune, the heart of Assisi, and admire the Temple of Minerva, a striking example of Roman architecture. Continue to the Basilica of Santa Chiara, dedicated to Saint Clare, and learning the life Blessed Carlo Acutis who dedicated his life to the Eucharist and evangelization through technology. And explore the quaint streets lined with artisan shops and cafes, all set

against the breathtaking backdrop of the Umbrian hills. In the evening, return to your hotel for a relaxing and well-deserved dinner in hotel (B, D)

Day 7) Sept, 30 – Assisi → Rome

Depart for Rome and check in at your hotel. In the afternoon, enjoy a guided tour of the Vatican Museums, marveling at their vast collection of art and historical treasures, and continue to the breathtaking Sistine Chapel to admire Michelangelo's masterpiece on the ceiling. After the tour, return to your hotel and enjoy a relaxing dinner, either at the hotel or at a nearby restaurant.) (B, D)

Day 8) Oct, 01 – Rome

Embark on a guided tour of Baroque Rome, wandering through its elegant squares, grand fountains, and historic streets. Along the way, indulge in a tasting of traditional Roman specialties, including the sweet maritozzo, savory supplì, pizza with mortadella, and the classic tiramisu, immersing yourself in the city's rich culinary and cultural heritage. In the afternoon, enjoy some free time for personal exploration or shopping, discovering Rome at your own pace. In the evening, delight in a dinner at a traditional restaurant, accompanied by a captivating opera performance, combining the city's culinary and cultural charms for a memorable night. (B, D)

Day 9) Oct, 02 – Rome → Sorrento

Depart by bus for Sorrento and check in at your hotel. In the afternoon, visit a charming local farmhouse, where you can watch skilled artisans craft fresh mozzarella by hand. Immerse yourself in the aromas of the countryside and enjoy tasting a variety of farm-produced specialties, including lemon and spiced oils, lemon and orange marmalade, honey from the farm's own bees, limoncello, and creamy lemon liqueur. The experience concludes with a relaxing dinner, allowing you to fully savor the authentic flavors of the region in a warm, rustic setting (B, D)

Day 10) Oct, 03 – Amalfi Coast

Enjoy a full-day boat excursion along the stunning Amalfi Coast. Depart from Sorrento and cruise along the sparkling coastline, stopping at the picturesque towns of Positano and Amalfi. Wander through their charming streets, admire the colorful cliffside houses, and take in the breathtaking coastal views. Enjoy a tasting of authentic limoncello, a true specialty of the region. Return to Sorrento and relax at your hotel after a day of unforgettable scenery, flavors, and exploration. Dinner in hotel or restaurant nearby (B, D)

Day 11) Oct, 04 – Capri

Enjoy a full-day excursion to the enchanting island of Capri from Sorrento. The experience includes a scenic boat tour around the island, offering stunning views of its dramatic cliffs, hidden grottoes, and crystal-clear waters. Explore the island at your leisure, taking in its charming villages, vibrant gardens, and breathtaking panoramas. Return to Sorrento in the evening after a day of unforgettable sights and island charm. Farewell dinner in local restaurant in Sorrento (B, D)
