# Ireland & Scotland

### October 24th to November 3, 2025



Your adventure begins with an overnight flight to Shannon Airport. Rest up as you prepare to explore the Emerald Isle.

Day 2 – Welcome to Ireland & Killarney

Upon arrival, meet your private driver and travel to the charming town of Killarney. Along the way, we will stop in Adare, a picturesque village known for its thatched cottages and historic landmarks like Adare Castle. Once in Killarney, enjoy a warm Irish welcome with a drink reception followed by a delicious 4-course dinner.

Day 3 – Explore Killarney at Your Leisure

Day 4 – Slea Head Drive & Dingle

Visit historical sites such as the Gallarus Oratory, a dry-stone early Christian church, and Dunbeg Fort, an Iron Age structure perched on the cliffs. #### Day 5 – Kinsale & Cobh

Travel to the coastal town of Kinsale, known for its medieval origins, winding streets, and vibrant harbor. Along the way, visit Cobh, a historic Titanic town that was the ship's last port of call. Learn about its role in Irish emigration and take in its unchanged beauty since the early 20th century.

Day 6 - Kilkenny: The Medieval City

Arrive in Kilkenny, a city steeped in history. Tour the magnificent Kilkenny Castle and explore the Medieval Mile, a discovery trail linking the castle to St. Canice's Cathedral and its 9th-century round tower. Don't miss the Smithwick's Experience, where you'll learn about Ireland's oldest ale. Wrap up the day with a 3-course dinner and perhaps a visit to one of Kilkenny's welcoming pubs.



Arrive in Dublin and immerse yourself in its rich culture and history. Visit the Guinness Storehouse to learn about Ireland's most famous beer, or take a walk across the iconic Ha'penny Bridge. Explore Dublin's vibrant shops, enjoy traditional Irish music at local pubs, and soak up the energy of Temple Bar.



Leave Dublin and journey north to Belfast. From here, board a ferry to Cairnryan, Scotland. On the way to Edinburgh, stop at Culzean Castle, a stunning clifftop estate surrounded by beautiful gardens. Arrive in Edinburgh and settle into your hotel for a 3-night stay.

Day 9 - Edinburgh, Scotland's Capital

Discover Edinburgh by taking a walking tour and include a visit to the iconic Edinburgh Castle. Together, enjoy the Scotch Whisky Experience at the top of the Royal Mile. Stroll along the Royal Mile, where you'll spot familiar scenes from Outlander and immerse yourself in its historic atmosphere. Browse unique shops, pick up Scottish souvenirs, and soak in the charm of this bustling city. Conclude your day with some leisure time to explore Edinburgh's vibrant nightlife.

#### Day 10 – Loch Lomond & Glasgow

Take a day trip through Scotland's heartland. Start at Stirling Castle, one of Scotland's grandest fortresses, and learn about its role in Scotlish history. Continue to Loch Lomond, for a tranquil cruise which crosses the lowlands of Central Scotland and the Highlands. Continue the day in Glasgow, exploring Buchanan Street, George Square, and the majestic Glasgow Cathedral. Return to Edinburgh for a farewell 3-course dinner, celebrating the memories you've made.

Day 11 – Farewell to Scotland
